Don't be Scammed on the Phone

Several of our members have been scammed recently by thieves who took advantage of their trust and generosity. It is easy to be cheated out of hundreds or even thousands of dollars. There are lots of ways that this can happen, but one of the most common ways is that someone calls with a lie that is somewhat believable. They say that they need your help, or that you have won something, or that something is wrong with your card or account. They may say they are from your financial institution or even the IRS. Some have even led the member to believe that they were a grandchild, or simply befriended a member who is lonely. Their tactics are endless. Once they establish contact, they usually ask that you send them money, buy a gift card and send them the card details, or deposit a fraudulent check and send them part of the funds. Often, they are in a hurry and ask that you don't tell anyone about the transaction. Please don't be fooled, and don't give anyone your personal information. Never buy a gift card or deposit a check or send money at a stranger's request. It is guaranteed to be a scam. People who call from your financial institutions already know all of your relevant information and won't need to ask. The IRS never initiates contact with people by phone. If you are still unsure if a call is legitimate, get a call back number and hang up. Contact someone you trust like your credit union to help you decide if the call is trustworthy.
